## Working with a single file:

- 1. Select either the 'Internal Storage' or 'USB Device' icon
- 2. Open by selecting any folders
- 3. Press and hold the file that you want to work with until a new screen 'File Operations' appears
- 4. Select which function you want to perform
  - If you select Delete follow the prompts

- If you select 'Copy' or 'Move' then once selected you will then need to choose where you want to copy or move the file to (e.g. if you are working with a picture file on the USB Device, once you have selected it to copy or move it you will then need to choose the medium (e.g. Internal Storage) you want to copy to, then select the appropriate folder, and then select the 'Files/Folder' icon to bring up the Master Operation screen. From here you can select 'Paste.'

### File types:

The CS-1 works with a wide variety of file types including Videos, Pictures and Music. If you try and open a file that the CS-1 does not recognise it will ask you to try and define it by bringing up a screen with options. In the event that the CS-1 does not recognise your file type you may need to go back to your source and reformat the file into one that the CS-1 can work with.
